





Call for Papers - International Conference

One World, Many Crises: Politics, Law, and Beyond

7-8 March 2023 | Athens, Greece

The Center for Research on Democracy and Law (https://kedid.uom.gr/en/; University of Macedonia, Greece), the COST Action "Global Atrocity Justice Constellations" (https://justice-360.com/; CA18228), and the Institute of European Integration and Policy (https://eeep-en.pspa.uoa.gr/, National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, Greece) co-organize the international conference "One World, Many Crises: Politics, Law, and Beyond" on 7-8 March 2023 at the University of Athens (Amphitheater "Ioannis Drakopoulos", Panepistimiou 30, Athens, Greece). The aim of the conference is to address:

- the current global challenges, notably the crisis of democratic governance, populism, disinformation, etc.;
- the impact of an increasingly globalized world on legal and political governance, especially in terms of crises (e.g., the war in Ukraine) or adjudicating bodies (e.g., ICC or ICJ);
- the past and possible future health issues, including crises and responses (e.g., the COVID-19 pandemic) as well as bioethical concerns (e.g., cultured food);
- the environmental issues within the ongoing climate change debate, including impact on humans (e.g., sustainable growth, environmental protection);
- the growing concerns over Artificial Intelligence and its impact on humans,

at a national, regional, and/or global level through a multidisciplinary approach from the perspectives of political science, social science, law, medicine, philosophy, humanities, etc.

The **thematic areas** of the conference draw primarily, either from a theoretical or an applied (e.g., case studies) perspective, from: democratic theory, transnational/local governance, and public policy; international and national/comparative law, including the judiciary; EU politics, institutions, integration, democracy; and health studies, governance, management. Panels/papers on additional areas may be considered.

We invite paper or panel proposals (for panels) on the above issues from any discipline, as well as from established practitioners in related fields, in English or Greek, which should include a 200-word abstract and a brief biography (1 paragraph) of each (co)author (for panels, the convenor should submit in one email separate abstracts/biographies for each paper/author), by 14 January 2024 31 December 2023 through the online platform at https://kedid.uom.gr/en/activities/conferences/one-world-many-crises/.
